


## Alpha Xi's Initiate 'Greek Spring Sing'

Occupied for two years, the Theta Xi house is located at 822 West 26th. Mrs. Gladys Rose, retired KSC art instructor, is the housemother.




## 'Sig Tau Eternal Light' Burns at Their New Fraternity House




# Phi Kappa Tau National Fraternity

# Panhellenic, IFC Sponsor First All Greek Dance


The first annual All Greek dance, under the sponsorship of Panhellenic and Inter-Fraternity Council, was held in January.


